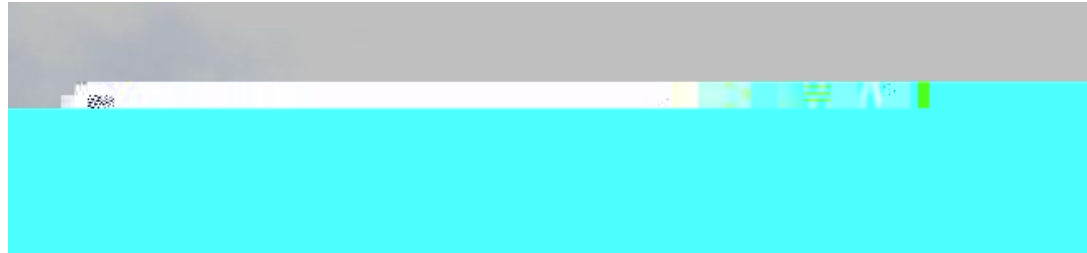

Composition + Requirements + Powers

Composition

Four (4) Executives

Four (4) Councillors

Four (4) Members-at-Large

Applications are open for members-at-large on the Board of Directors

The General Manager is an *ex-o icio* and non-voting member.

Requirements

Must be at least 18 years of age

Citizen or permanent resident of Canada

Not be bankrupt

Not have been declared incapable by a court

Not have a criminal record

Powers

Highest governing body of the SSMU

Responsible for the SSMU's:

Legal
