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6.4. The SSMU, through the Accessibility and Equity Committees and the Offices of the Vice-President (External Affairs)

7.3. To facilitate continuous improvement in the accessibility of SSMU-run spaces, the SSMU will execute an Accessibility Audit of the building on a bi-annual basis and will develop a series of recommendations to the Legislative Council for making spaces within the building more accessible.

The SSMU, through the Office of the Vice-President (Student Life) and the Accessibility Commissioner, will ensure the maintenance of accessibility and inclusion among student groups through the provision of resources and awareness regarding accessibility issues.

8.1. The Vice-President (Student Life), in consultation with the Accessibility Commissioner, will be responsible for educating student groups on issues of access through the inclusion of accessibility information in training materials made available to student groups, including but not limited to the inclusion of accessibility content in Club Workshops, at the Services Summit, and in the SSMU online resources.

8.2. The Accessibility Commissioner will be responsible for the production and annual maintenance of a master list of accessible venues to be identified as priority venues for event bookings for student groups. The accessible venue list will be paralleled by a "blacklist" of off-limits venues.

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
